



2017 WTT TWIN CITIES LEAGUE INFORMATION



Description: Grab your co-workers, your friends, or your neighbors and hit the courts with us! In WTT, co-ed teams comprised of at least two men and two women compete in matches consisting of one set each of men's and women's doubles, men's and women's singles and two sets of mixed doubles. This unique format, which is also played by the pros, features no-ad scoring, substitutions, and coaching from the sidelines. The program was co-founded by Billy Jean King in 1985 and provides opportunities for advancement to regional and national competition. Teams compete weekly in one of five divisions based on NTRP rating: 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5 or Open.

Location: All matches are played at the Baseline Tennis Center (mostly outdoors).

Team Fee: \$450 - This covers all court and league fees for the entire season (there are no facility fees on match days). The total number of players you have and whether or not you have a corporate sponsor will affect your individual team member costs. For example, if you have a 10 person team with no sponsor, the cost per person would be \$45 for the entire season.

Duration: Play begins the week of June 5 and runs through August 11. There are 8 weeks of play with a few buffer weeks built into the season for rain cancellations. No matches will be scheduled during the July 4th holiday week.

Days of Play:

Tuesdays: 3.5, 4.5, and NEW Open Division

Wednesday: 3.0 and 4.0 Division

Balls: Two new cans of balls are needed for a team match. The home team is responsible for bringing balls. If you would like to order a case of balls through Saint Paul Urban Tennis, please contact us before May 15.

2017 WTT TWIN CITIES RULES OF NOTE:

WTT Twin Cities will follow National Recreational League Rules which can be found at www.wtt.com. There is no longer a corporate requirement that 50% of the team must be from the same company/workplace, although we encourage teams to seek corporate sponsorship and affiliation.

Winning teams of our WTT Twin Cities League will be eligible to play in one of several Mylan WTT National Qualifier Events. Our Open Division teams advance directly to Nationals (any team may attend) that is held in Indian Wells, CA.

Team ratings are determined by averaging the NTRP ratings of the top 2 men and top 2 women on the team. Subs that are filling in must be added to the team roster and abide by this rule.
